



## ***ISSB Preparation Course Outline***

5 days a week  
Session hour approx. 1 hour

### **Basic Personality Series (Day 1 to 3)**

- Introduction. (Interactive session based on questionnaire).
- Self-Description (Interactive session based on questionnaire).
- Priorities, goals and achievements. (Interactive session based on questionnaire).
- Introduction to tests at ISSB and Clarification of doubts about tests at ISSB. (lecture).
- Importance and filling of Bio Data form. (Practice - discussion)
- Improving English, confidence and leadership (lecture / video)
- Apart from above 10 x **Videos** to watch (10-15 minutes each).
- Quiz test (GK and English as own time work).

### **Psychological Tests (Day 3 to 10)**

- **Introduction to psychological test**, main aspects applicable to all personality tests. (lecture)
- **Sentence writing** (WAT and SAT), lecture and notes.
- WAT work sheets (3x work sheets to be done followed by discussion with instructor).
- **Story writing** (lecture and notes).
- Story writing (4 stories to be written followed by discussion with instructor).
- **OPI Test & SRT** (Lecture and notes).
- OPI Test (1 to 2, live online test – links shared for practice and results followed by clarification of doubts).
- SRT (live quiz practice (own time work), practice (pdf) and discussion)



- SRT Quiz tests (own time work) and clarification of doubts with instructor.
- 2x videos (15 -20 minutes each)
- *Mock test* and discussion of written work with instructor.

### Communication and Planning Series (Day 11-15)

- *Essay writing* (lecture and pdf notes).
- Essay writing practice-1 + discussion of written work with instructor.
- Essay writing practice-2 + discussion of written work with instructor.
- Essay writing practice-3 + discussion of written work with instructor.
- *Lecture* (lecture, pdf notes on topics)
- Lecture (practice-1 and discussion with instructor)
- Lecture (practice-2 and discussion with instructor)
- Lecture (practice-3 and discussion with instructor)
- *Group Discussion* Lecture and practice
- Group Discussion practice-2
- *Group planning* (lecture and notes).
- Group planning (practice – own time work).

### Interview at ISSB (Day 15 to 18)

- Interview (lectures (2) and discussion).
- Mock interview -1 and discussion.
- Mock interview -2 and discussion.

### GTO Tests (18-21)

- GTO Tests – Overall concepts and requirement (lecture).
- Group discussion (already covered).
- Group planning (already covered).
- Lecturette (already covered).
- Command Task (lecture and pdf notes).
- Command Task (on sketch practice, own time).
- Individual Obstacle (lecture and discussion).
